UNIONDALE HIGH SCHOOL JAZZ BAND: The Jazz Band of the Uniondale High School conducted by Director Colton Wynter provided holiday musical accompaniment to UCC members and residents of the Uniondale Community. What a bunch of talented kids. Keep up the fantastic work. Your community is proud of you!

COMMUNITY CONCERNS: Clara Eromisele of Uniondale Weed & Seek states that program is progressing nicely. A technology center is being implemented at the UCC office to process free tax returns for Uniondale residents to be filed electronically. Family income should be under \$35K and individual income should be under 15K. They are presently seeking at least 10 volunteers to be trained to educate residents about loan shark loans, rapid refunds, etc.

Lorie Boyd from the Vocational & Educational Office, a NYS agency with the NYS Education Dept informed that her dept provides training for adults with disabilities to become more self-sufficient. She needs the community to be aware of these important services. Her district office is located in Hempstead and they ready and willing to serve the Uniondale community. CBAPP Denise Marone funded through a five year grant. The NY Health Dept informed residents that Uniondale has a high rate of teen pregnancy. Her agency is working with UCC, Grace Cathedral, STRONG and Planned Parenthood to combat the issue. Their goals are to promote abstinence, stress sexual protection, reduce teen pregnancies, increase self esteem and personal appearance and educate teenagers regarding sexually transmitted diseases. The program is enhanced by interactive computer modules. The kids can learn and have fun at the same time.

Uniondale Community Council (UCC) Youth Project - Exec Director Lorraine Danser: Overall programs are great with Christmas parties at each location extremely appreciated. TASK plans to purchase five computer modules containing interactive online software to promote self esteem, community involvement, personal appearance and successful personal relationships. 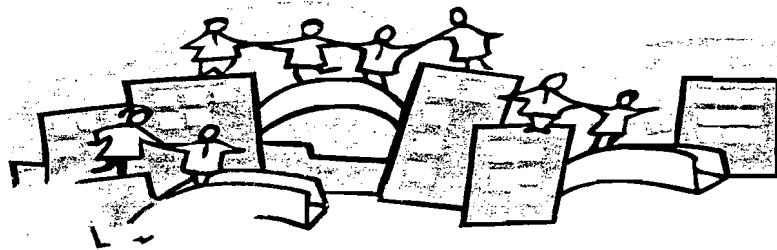
